Northeast Christian Academy (NCA) in Kingwood, Texas, is many things. Students are required to perform 20 hours of community service per year, before graduating. At the same time, there's more to life at NCA than work. Most students find time for a wide variety of co-curricular activities, such as Beta Club, Student Council, the National Honor Society, performing arts, and much more.

NCA has one of the most competitive athletic programs in the region. In the past 10 years, the Warriors have won state basketball championships four times, the swim team boasts four state championships, and the baseball team has won state championships for three consecutive years.
